Ldy Wake Mrs Carter &c. (at 11 o'clock.)

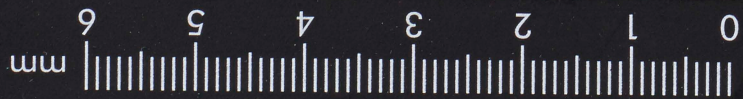
I have not forgot our engagement to W. W.
