I did not answer the

thing you can imagine to
the Duchess that is most respected
and assure Her Grace (which is
very true) that I am much disap-
pointed, as usual was made
happy the days I passed with
you & wished much to have
repeated the visit - as soon as
the Duchess comes to Town I will
wait upon Her & thank Her
