very sincerely

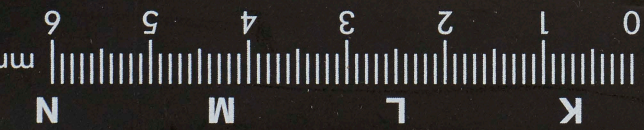
